Lesson 21:	Jesus Calls the Children
Scripture:	Matthew 19:13-15; Mark 10:13-16; Luke 18:15-17
Aim:	For the child to learn that Jesus loves and welcomes children into His forever family.
Story Overview:	Jesus took time from His teaching to spend time with the little children. He wanted to share God's great love with them.
Memory Verse:	John 13:34 – <i>"Love one another."</i>
Memory Verse Song:	John 13:34 Sung to a favorite song in your country
Scripture Song:	Sung to a favorite Bible song in your country.

Bible Story: Get ready!! Let's go to see Jesus. I imagine you would be just as excited as the boys and girls were in our Bible story today. They heard about how wonderful He was and they knew Jesus taught all about God and how much God loved them. Now they were going to get to see Jesus and maybe even talk to Him!

The children and their mothers hurried down the road to where Jesus was teaching. As they got closer, they became excited about being able to talk to Jesus. As the mothers tried to move their children through the crowd to get closer to Jesus, they were turned away. Jesus' helpers said the children shouldn't bother Jesus when He had work to do. Jesus was too busy and didn't have time to see the children today. The helpers told them to go away.

The mothers and children were so sad! They had come all this way, and now Jesus was too busy for them. The mothers and children sadly turned to go back home. Wait, someone was calling them. As they looked around, they saw Jesus was calling them! "Do not go away," Jesus said. "Children come, children come."

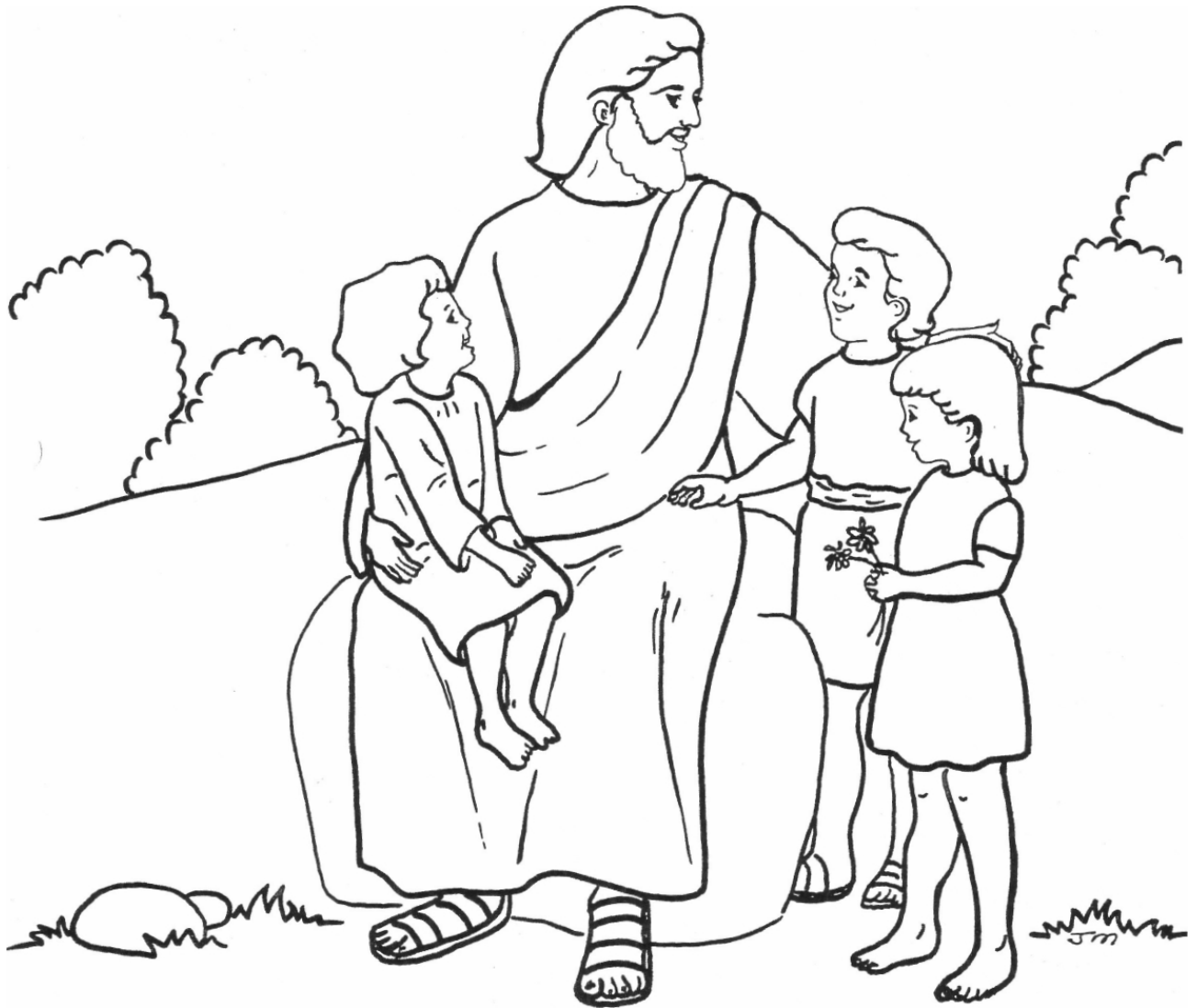
Then Jesus said to His helper, "Let the little children come to Me, don't send them away." As Jesus said this, the people in the crowd made a pathway so the mothers could bring their children to Jesus. Jesus smiled as the children quickly ran to Him. Life Application: We need to tell God we have done wrong things and want not to do them any more.
