Psalm 9:10 "And those who know Thy Name will put their trust in Thee; for Thou, O Lord, hast not forsaken those who seek Thee."

A: Adoration C: Confession T: Thanksgiving S: Supplication

1 Yahweh-Jehovah: Most High God—Core Group Leaders

Psalm 83:18 "That they may know that you alone, whose name is the Lord, are the Most High over all the earth."

A: God of Might and Authority.

C: Serving in our strength, forgetting the authority of our Most High God/ Confess when Christ's authority is removed in service.

T: He has called us to serve Him and He equips.

S: Ask the Lord to reveal His Highness to each one personally.

4 Elo-Him: Creator—Children

John 1:1 "In the beginning was the Word and the Word was with God, and the Word was God."

A: Creator God.

C: Our world's untruth about creation.

T: The Word never changes and can be trusted.

S: Faith in the unchanging Word and it's validity in our lives.

7 Jehovah-Shamah: Lord is Present—Children's Supervisors and Teachers

Psalm 46:1 "God is our refuge and strength, a very present help in trouble."

A: He is always present.

C: Wandering from Him.

T: He never leaves us and He is our helper.

S: How to rejoice always in His presence.

2 The Name: Hashem—Leadership Day for TDs & ATDs

1 Kings 8:29 "...that your eyes may be open night and day toward this house, the place of which you have said, My name shall be there..."

A: Power of His name as we gather to serve Him.

C: He alone is enough, we need nothing else.

T: His presence with us, His name is there as we gather.

S: Everything to be done for His honour and glory.

5 Adonai: Lord, Master—Board of Directors

John 13:13 "You call me Teacher and Lord, and you are right, for so I am."

A: All authority belongs to You our Teacher and Lord.

C: When we have forgotten His leadership.

T: Wisdom and direction You give.

S: Lord, teach and continue to direct our Board of Directors.

8 Jehovah-Roi: Shepherd—AV/ Treasurer/Secretaries

1 Peter 5:4 "And when the Chief Shepherd appears, you will receive the unfading crown of glory."

A: Our leader.

C: What do you battle in the flesh without the Shepherd's help?

T: Recognizing our work for Your Kingdom.

S: Grace to do Your work and not draw attention to self.

3 Jehovah-Nissi: Our Banner—Teaching Directors

Psalm 60:4 "But for those who fear you, you have raised a banner to be unfurled against the bow."

A: The Lord is our Conqueror. He is our sign of conquest.

C: What is my banner?...self, knowledge, position, pride...?

T: We are crucified to Christ and He is our banner.

S: Give God His rightful place and He teaches us how serve under His banner. Strength in the role.

6 Yahweh-Melek: King—CBS International

Psalm 24:7 "Lift up your heads, O gates! And be lifted up, O ancient doors that the King of glory may come in."

A: King of glory, Ruler of the World.

C: The World's rejection of the King of glory.

T: Growth of CBS International.

S: Gates of people's hearts will be open to the "King of glory."

9 Abba-Father—Youth and Teens

Romans 8:15 "The Spirit Himself bears witness with our spirit that we are children of God."

A: Father, Lover of our souls.

C: Doubting His love.

T: Your love for us is everlasting, You want good things for our teens.

S: Our youth and teens to know the unique love of Christ, and be centered around it.

10 Jehovah-Repheka: Our Healer—Sick

Jeremiah 17:14 "Heal me, O Lord, and I will be healed; save me and I will be saved, for you are the one I praise."

A: He is the restorer of our souls.

C: Help our unbelief.

T: For fullness of life in Jesus.

S: What do you need healing from? The Lord will bring names of those who need a touch from Him.

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11 Jehovah-Elyon: Extreme Sovereignty and Majesty and His Highest Pre-eminence—

Class members/Core groups
Luke 10:23 “Blessed are the eyes that see what You see!”

A: Supreme over all. We can do nothing without Him.

C: Confess what you need to relinquish to His Majesty.

T: The revealer of truths, seeing through the eyes of our Majesty as we study and live it out.

S: What victories have you experienced as truths being revealed through the study?

14 ISH-Husband—Widows, fatherless, orphans, etc.

Isaiah 54:5 “For your husband is your Maker, whose name is the Lord of Hosts; and your Redeemer is the Holy One of Israel, who is called the God of the earth.”

A: Our Maker is our husband, who chose to fill the role.

C: Believing the lies of the enemy when we are in the valley.

T: You know those who need a special touch from You.

S: How can we be Your hands and feet in this sometimes lonely world.

17 El-Chay: Living God—Prayer Chairs

2 Kings 19:16 “Incline your ear, O Lord, and hear; open your eyes, O Lord and see...”

A: You are the Living God who hears and sees.

C: When we forget this truth as we approach Him.

T: He knows we are weak and He has pity on us.

S: More of an awareness of His presence and awe in His presence. Renewed strength.

12 El-Shaddai: God Almighty—National Servants Team

Genesis 17:1-2 “When Abraham was ninety-nine years old the Lord appeared to him and said, ‘I am God Almighty; walk before me, and be blameless, that I may make my covenant between me and you, and may multiply you greatly.’”

A: You are Mighty God of Covenant, faithful to the core.

C: Carrying burdens that belong to the Lord.

T: Faithfulness in our lives.

S: We trust that He alone will do the work of multiplying us, asking Him how we fit in.

15 Esh-Oklah (AISH o-KLAH): Consuming Fire—Prayer & Fasting Day

Romans 12:1 “I appeal to you therefore, brothers, by the mercies of God, to present your bodies as a living sacrifice, holy and acceptable to God, which is your spiritual worship.”

A: Refiner

C: Whatever the Lord needs to burn in us. What do we desire from the Lord? Why are we fasting personally and corporately?

T: Your mercies are new everyday.

S: Teach us how to worship you.

18 Jehovah Maon: Refuge, Strong Tower—Class Partners

Proverbs 18:10 “The name of the Lord is a fortified tower; the righteous run to it and are safe.”

A: You are our safe house and security.

C: Impatience as we wait for more class partners.

T: You open doors of opportunity to serve.

S: Reminders of your provision in the past. Confidence in our refuge and dwelling place.

13 Jehovah-Tseboth: Lord of Hosts—Family

Isaiah 28:29 “This also comes forth from the Lord of Hosts, who is wonderful in counsel and excellent in worship.”

A: The Lord of Hosts is our Warrior.

C: Times of neglecting/not seeking the wonderful counsel of the Lord about family members.

T: He wages war for the lives of the unsaved.

S: How to pray and fight as the Lord’s warrior; He leads we follow.

16 Yahweh-Mekaddesh: Makes Us Holy—Spiritual Warfare

2 Corinthians 10:4 “The weapons of our warfare are not the weapons of the world.”

A: We are set apart because of His Holiness.

C: Fighting the Spiritual with carnal weapons (personalize).

T: Prayer is power from heaven to defeat the enemy.

S: To see our daily battles through the eyes of the Lord and fight His way.

19 Qanna: Jealous God—Confession

Exodus 20:5 “You shall not bow down to them or serve them, for I the Lord your God am a jealous God...”

A: You are the only God. Lord, you made us, redeemed us and we belong to you.

C: The Spirit to remind us of any idols we place before you.

T: For your love.

S: Spirit to help us acknowledge and ask for help with all we put before the Lord.

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20 Elo-Olam: Everlasting God—Satellite Groups

Psalm 90:1-2 “Lord, you have been our dwelling place in all generations. Before the mountains were brought forth, or ever you had formed the earth and the world, from everlasting to everlasting you are God.”

A: Infinite God.

C: How have we put the Lord under time constraints?

T: There is no end to You. We can depend on Your plans for us.

S: To see as He sees and wait on Him.

23 Shopet: Judge—Nations

Psalm 94:15 “For justice will return to the righteous, and all the upright in heart will follow it.”

A: Righteous Judge of the whole world.

C: Forgetting to pray for the world that has gone astray.

T: Righteous hearts that will follow Him. Justice that will prevail.

S: Ask the Lord to place a love for a country or group that need the Lord on your heart and pray.

26 Jehovah-Jireh—Growth

Genesis 22:13-14 “On the mount of the Lord it shall be provided.”

A: He is the Builder of the house and Sustainer of it.

C: Areas of our lives where we have doubted His provision.

T: He alone gets the glory for where we are and where He plans to take us.

S: Ask for practical ways to grow our faith and hold onto His promises.

21 Miqweh-Yisreal: Hope of Israel—Prayer Groups

Jeremiah 17:7 “Blessed is the man who trusts in the Lord, whose trust is in Him.”

A: He is our assured foundation.

C: Confess any foundation other than Christ.

T: Our hope and confidence will not be put to shame.

S: Please give us insight, encouragement and zeal to pray.

24 Jehovah-Shalom: Our Peace—Coordinators

I Corinthians 15:57-58 “But thanks be to God, who gives us the victory through our Lord Jesus Christ....be steadfast, immovable, always abounding in the work of the Lord, knowing that in the Lord your labour is not in vain.”

A: He is our peace.

C: Forgetting victory through the Lord.

T: He is steadfast and immovable, our anchor.

S: Infilling of the Spirit always so we represent Him and are fruitful.

27 Yahweh-Rophe: Restorer, Healer—Senior Leaders

Proverbs 4:20-22 “Turn your ear to my words. Do not let them out of your sight, keep them within your heart; for they are life to those who find them and health to one’s whole body.

A: He heals spiritually, emotionally, physically, etc.

C: Limiting the Lord. How are we hindering Your healing in us?

T: Nothing is too hard for You.

S: What do we need to relinquish to You?

22 Jehovah-Tsidqenu: Our Righteous God—Unity

Jeremiah 26:3 “In his days Judah will be saved, and Israel will dwell securely. And this is the name by which He will be called: The Lord is our righteousness.”

A: Our righteousness is in Christ.

C: Confess attitudes or thoughts that have hindered others from Christ.

T: Christ forgives our sins that divide.

S: To see others as He sees, salvation of the World. Unite us as one.

25 Jehovah Y’Shua: Saviour—Unsaved

Hebrews 7:25 “Therefore He is able to save completely those who come to God through Him, because He always lives to intercede for them.”

A: Salvation is from Christ alone.

C: Truthfully ask ourselves how much compassion we have for the lost.

T: He knows the lost and has not forgotten them.

S: What are You asking each one to do for the unsaved in their lives?

28 Eli-Roi: God That Sees You—Associate Teaching Directors

Psalm 34:15 “The eyes of the Lord are toward the righteous and His ears toward their cry.”

A: Nothing escapes You, Lord.

C: When/how you’ve forgotten the “seeing God”.

T: Love and care.

S: Open eyes to see Him.

Exodus 3:15 God also said to Moses, “Say to the Israelites, ‘The Lord, the God of your fathers – the God of Abraham, the God of Isaac and the God of Jacob – has sent me to you.’ This is my name forever, the name you shall call me from generation to generation.”

Teach us how to impact this generation for your glory.
